REGULAR SWIMMING POOL MAINTENANCE

Thank you for your enquiry into regular swimming pool maintenance with Buy & Fit Pool Shop.

We have been servicing swimming pools across Melbourne for over 3 decades, and offer a variety of packages to suit your swimming pool needs.

WATER BALANCE & TREATMENT

Water balance is the core of maintaining a swimming pool. Sanitisation is essential for keeping water in a condition safe for swimming, but unbalanced pool water also leads to a corrosive effect on both the pool and its related equipment i.e. pumps, filters etc. Correctly balanced pool water maximises the life of your swimming pool, ensuring a safe, healthy and fun swimming environment.

Balancing pool water is a dynamic process where each chemical added effects another parameter. For example, chlorine has a very high pH, and chlorine is most active when in a certain pH range. Hydrochloric acid needs to be added to bring the pH down and into the correct range. But adding acid reduces the total alkalinity, so pH buffer is added to balance total alkalinity. This process continues through all aspects of water balance including water hardness, iron content, total dissolved solids and phosphates.

Water balance is also constantly reacting to environmental factors such as sunshine, rain, swimming in the pool and debris in the pool. This is why regular testing and treatment of pool water is an essential part of owning a swimming pool.







LET US DO THE DIRTY WORK

Removing dirt and debris from the pool is the second part of regular pool maintenance. In the peak of Summer, a pool can turn green in 48 hours if chlorine levels suddenly drop and there is debris for algae to bloom from. Scooping out leaves and branches, brushing dust and dirt from pool walls and steps, vacuuming of the pool floor and emptying leaves from baskets are all part of a regular maintenance visit from Buy & Fit Pool Shop.

KEEPING YOUR SYSTEM RUNNING SMOOTHLY

Lastly, pool equipment running between regular maintenance visits will keep the pool in good condition. We always inspect all equipment during our visit, and while every eventuality cannot be planned for, we endeavour to identify equipment issues before they stop working.

Service must be kept all year round for these rates to apply, however you can change the frequency of visits over the course of the year to reflect your seasonal requirements. Rates will default to prices as listed above.

While the rates above will be applicable to most pools, we do need to reserve the right to adjust these rates if your pool requires unusually high levels of maintenance. Some factors which may affect the rate include:

- Large water volume (over 100,000 litres)
- Cartridge Filter, depending on cartridge filters setup and size.
- Poor water circulation causing constant algae outbreaks
- Equipment in bad condition which dramatically increases the cleaning time

Please note that where these conditions are present, more frequent visits will able us to better maintain the pool and decrease the likelihood of a rate adjustment.

PRO-ACTIVE CHEMICAL TREATMENTS

The basic parameters of water balance (chlorine, acid, buffer, salt) will always be tested and balanced at any pool service. In addition to this, a pro-active schedule of algaecides and clarifiers will keep the pool looking great between visits.

The programme involves a cycle of the following chemical treatments:

- Benzalkonium Chloride kills any green algae present in the water.
- Copper Based Algaecide kills black algae, prevents green and black algae forming.
- Metal Free Algaecide kills any green, blue and black algae present in the water.
- Phosphate Starver removes phosphates, the food algae feeds on.
- Slow Release Clarifier some dirt and algae particles are too fine to be filtered. Clarifiers combine with these
 particles, making them large enough to be picked up in the filter. This reduces the need for chlorine and
 gives the pool water that sparkling quality.

Typically, a pro-active chemical treatment program adds around \$50.00 monthly to the cost of pool service. It is

important to remember though that chemical treatment of a green pool can easily cost \$300.00 to \$500.00. Proactive chemicals treatments ensure a safe and healthy swimming environment whenever you require the pool. Replacing these items in a timely manner prevents further costs arising from issues not being attended to. We would request that you pre-authorise replacement of these items up to the value of \$100.00. Items over this amount will be quoted as they arise.  Service call fee incl 30 minutes labour: \$278.00 Labour rate over 30 minutes: \$138.00 per hour charged in 15 minute increments after 30 mins
Please note that if a return visit for an ongoing issue is required, only one service call for the initial visit will be charged.
